18/1 Welcome and introduction

18/1.1 Chris Sage took the chair and welcomed everyone to the first committee meeting for over a year.

18/2.1 Alex Belson(AB) - (Diving Manager); Sheila Mackenzie (SM) – (County Secretary)

18/3 Background

18/3.1 CS highlighted the background as to there being no County competitions for two years. The Management Board (MB) had decided that the committee be suspended until all diving clubs joined in the committee meetings and county competitions. The committee was assured by JC that this meeting would be supported by the MB and that they would be very happy to see county diving competition happening with both clubs involved.

18/4 Minutes of the meeting on 8th November 2016

18/4.1 The minutes were accepted as a true record.

18/5 Matters arising from the minutes

18/5.1 Beaumont DA has purchased a full set of JPads

18/5.2 RP questioned the availability of the iPad offer made by the county. IM outlined the procedure. IM also outlined the development package offer of £ for £ up to £500. Both these funds are subject to SwimMark.

18/5.3 Regional conference will be led by Alexei Evangulov early in 2018. IM reminded the clubs that they need to respond to Amy Bryant's request for ideas for subjects. DB expressed his views and was encouraged to pass them to Amy.

18/5.4 There is to be a regional judge's update/course 24th February 2018 at Latton Bush, Harlow. IM pointed out that the county will reimburse any registration fees for official's courses.

18/6 Correspondence

18/6.1 Becky Walker sent out a letter inviting regions to submit names of young potential officials that can be fast tracked. There will be a course alongside a meet at Southend 2-4 March 2018. There was no one from Hertfordshire that was appropriate.

18/7 National Diving Management Group

18/7.1 The county does not have a representative on the NDMG, but DB is on it as a specialist and IM is on it as the representative from the Sport Governing Board

18/7.2 DB raised that the judging at the London Skills was poor, The committee expects that the region will feed back on this point.

18/7.3 In 2018 the Skills is expected to be in Manchester if the current issues can be resolved. Alternatively, they may be held in Sunderland.

18/7.4 The next meeting is 7th March 2018

18/8 County Competition 2018

18/8.1 Having discussed the competitions held in 2015, RP reported that the Dacorum DC were not prepared to take part in any county competition in 2018 other than the Championships

18/8.2 JC proposed that the only competitions to take place in 2018 should be County Junior / Senior Championship competitions.
