Present - Pete Mole, Edna Scott and Jon Lowy

1 - Neil Cook is temporarily working away and has stepped down, Tina Canty has also stepped down as she does not have any spare time, unfortunately Rose Younger would prefer to coach girls rather than be involved in managing/developing polo and therefore has also stepped down.

2 - Watford decided not to enter a team and therefore the leagues are as follows - Div 1 Cambridge, Bedford, Hatfield, Dunstable and Spalding. Div 2 Hertford, Hitchin, Biggleswade, Northampton A, Northampton B, Milton Keynes. The reason for Watford leaving the league was that they did not want to play games in non deep deep pools and the committee whilst agreeing deep deep pools should be used whenever possible it could not impose this on all teams.

3 - Games for this season will be men only with the minimum age being 15 years old at the time of the game

4 - 8 teams will be taking place in the KO tournament in Northampton on Saturday 15/7/17 including junior and girls game.

5 - Whenever possible the committee will encourage pools and clubs to have junior polo open days

6 - Time clocks are available to any Herts based teams that wish to use them

7 - An u16 team is continuing combining Bishop Stortford, Hertford and Hitchin - in a league with Ipswich, Chelmsford and Colchester
