21/2 Declaration of conflict of interest

21/2.1 No conflict of interest was declared at this point.

21/3 Minutes of the previous meeting

21/3.1 All present had received a copy of the previous minutes and no queries or additions were noted at the

meeting.

21/4 Matters arising

21/4.1 The previous Actions were reviewed and updated under the main body of the meeting, no specific matters

arising.

21/5 Discipline specific areas – coaching

21/5.1 A general update was given from all clubs present all confirmed that they were back in the water after the

second significant lockdown period.

21/5.2 A discussion took place regarding the latest Covid guide lines and what this meant discipline specifically

for Artistic swimming around maintaining 1m distances in the water and minimising face to face routine work to be sub 3 seconds. We also confirmed that the latest guidance allowed lifts again but required all swimmers to come up out of the water looking in the same direction. This guidance is being updated

regularly so coaches are reminded to check the Swim England guidance as often as possible.

21/6 Discipline specific areas – Land Training Grades

21/6.1 (AB) shared that the East region is running a briefing session for Land grades 1 & 2 on the 27th of April. This will not replace the formal training or CPD sessions that are available but would help give coaches

who have not done the training a better understanding of what they are working towards. Anyone who is

interested can sign up via the East Region web site.

21/7 Discipline specific areas - officials

21/7.1 Nothing really to report as current courses have been postponed due to Covid 19 situation. No online official's courses are currently available for Synchronised swimming. It was discussed at the recent East

Region Artistic how many officials are currently still available at each club and all agreed that further

courses would be required as soon as we can start to run them again.

(TB) will advise when further information is available.

21/8 Discipline specific areas - competition

Discussion took place regarding the recent Level X competition for Artistic Swimming and it was explained to all how this is run on a remote basis with videos submitted for judging. (TB) Shared a presentation that had been delivered at the recent Swim England East Artistic Swimming Committee. It was shared that there was a range of completions planned over the remainder of the year and into next year. These would initially be Level X type competitions that would be run remotely finally leading back to pool based competition towards the beginning of next year (subject to ongoing covid restrictions etc). A brief summary is as follows however (TB) will share the Briefing pack with the full details.

Virtual Competition Series

- · National Championships September
- · National Age Group Championships October
- Masters Championships November
- Combo Cup December

21/9 Discipline specific areas – Skills days

21/9.1 TB advised that Skills assessment were now going to be virtual at least until August this year. Full details are also in the briefing pack that will be shared. In summary each club in the Region will be allowed to enter up to 10 swimmers for assessment. Video recording of each element will need to be submitted by a deadline for a panel of judges to score. Two weeks after the assessment date each club will be advised of the outcome of each swimmers assessment.

A guide of the time table below:-

- Register through region (over 3 weeks before)
- 3 weeks before submission Get names from clubs check
- 2 weeks before submission Send swimmer number and club codes.
- 1 week before submission Senior judge sends judges allocations
- · After submission deadline Files sorted into correct folders
- 1 week after submission Judges scores are submitted
- 2 weeks after submission Results sent to clubs and SE

21/9.2 (TB) to check with the East Region if a clubs full allocation of 10 is not used can other clubs increase their quota of entries for Skills days shared out across all clubs who would like to exceed their quota

21/10 Discipline specific areas - Pathway (LTS,8/9/10, Local Partnerships Beacon Program)

21/10.1 Nothing specific was recorded up this section other than due to the number of swimmers who had not returned to our clubs that it made sense for us to all make sure local pathways where they existed precovid are established

21/12 Development Days within Herts County (feedback, de-brief)

It was discussed that at present due to the continuing restrictions it would be difficult to run some traditional development days. Due to a general fall out of members during the lock down period it was agreed that perhaps a more general "Try Artistic Swimming Event" may make sense and help to encourage new participants. We agreed that instead of holding an event in one location across the County it would be better to have a distributed set of events over a weekend where each clubs holds their own local session.
