shadow at competitions to help build more understanding

22/53.1 This year's official competition season was now over for juniors so no real discussion on future events

however it was noted that the National Masters Championship was still due to take place in Nottingham on the 12<sup>th</sup> of November. We were pleased to say there would be a strong presence from the County with

both Aqualina and Hatfield taking part.

22/53.2 (JJ) had previously asked would it be possible for the County to consider something more fun based for

the clubs to compete in during the down-time between September and January. She had experience of something called Quadacquatic which covered Land and competitive swimming as well as Artistic swimming. Unfortunately (JJ) had not had time to investigate this so we left the action open.





(JJ) will check to see if she can find anything about this type of event if not she will pull something together for the group to consider.
