

## **Swim England Hertfordshire Management Board**

Members of the Swim England Hertfordshire Management Board must be Swim England members of a Swim England Hertfordshire club, but no particular skill or knowledge is required, only a desire to contribute impartially to the decision-making in the county for the benefit of our athletes in all the aquatic disciplines.

There are only four meetings per year at the moment, plus the Annual Council Meeting. The requirement of members is attendance at those meetings, having read the paperwork circulated prior to the meeting. Items are discussed and decisions made, as well as monitoring the work of the discipline committees. The meetings are held on a weekday evening, currently by Zoom, at 8pm and last, at maximum, for two hours.

There is no requirement for additional time or input, only if an individual wishes to expand their commitment.

At this year's Annual Council Meeting seven positions are due for election to serve on the Management Board, and nominations would be very welcomed from younger Swim England members. Any Swim England member of a Swim England Hertfordshire club, aged 18yrs or over, can serve on the Management Board.

It would be excellent if the full membership of fifteen could be achieved this year. Can you offer to become a Management Board Member?

## **Swim England Hertfordshire Managers/Officers**

There are four posts for election at this year's Annual Council Meeting scheduled for 18<sup>th</sup> March 2024.

These are – Diving Manager, Secretary, Trophies Officer and Water Polo Manager.

The Secretary is one of the three executive officers for the county. The executive officers have joint responsibility for overseeing the governance of Swim England Hertfordshire.

The Trophies Officer has responsibility for the provision of the various awards, medals, trophies and bannerettes required for the county competitions, as well as keeping records of stock and records of the recipients of the top awards.

Managers of Diving and Water Polo have responsibility for the co-ordination of the development of clubs and disciplines, and the delivery of events, working with members of the discipline committees.
